PRIZE REGULATIONS: ANNE BENNETT PRIZE

I. GENERAL

1. In 2013 the London Mathematical Society Council agreed to institute an Anne Bennett Prize in memory of Anne Bennett who died suddenly whilst working for the Society in 201

Prize, with the exception of the Berwick and Senior Berwick Prizes.  
Recipients of these prizes may be eligible for the Anne Bennett prize, provided they satisfy all other eligibility criteria.

4. The Prize shall be restricted to mathematicians who, on 1st January of the year of the award, are either (i) normally resident in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, or (ii) members of the Society mainly
6. The prize shall only be awarded to mathematicians who on the 1st January of the year of its award have fewer than 10 years (full time equivalent) of involvement in mathematics at postdoctoral level, allowing for breaks in continuity, or who in the opinion of the Prizes Com
