

LONDON MATHEMATICAL SOCIETY PRIZE REGULATIONS: WHITEHEAD PRIZE

- I. GENERAL
- 1. In 1973 the London Mathematical Society instituted a Senior Whitehead Prize in memory of Professor J. H. C. Whitehead (LMS President, **1955**). The Whitehead Fund for this purpose was made up of contributions from a large number of Professor Whitehead's friends, and a generous donation from Mrs Whitehead.

In 1978 the Society decided to institute Whitehead Prizes to be funded by the same moneys.

- 2. The award of the Whitehea®rizes shall be considered annually by the Council of the Society.
- 3. Normally not more thasix Whitehead Prizes shall be awarded in any year.
