



LONDON MATHEMATICAL SOCIETY
PRIZE REGULATIONS: WHITEHEAD PRIZE

I. GENERAL

1. In 1973 the London Mathematical Society instituted a Senior Whitehead Prize in memory of Professor J. H. C. Whitehead (LMS President, **1953**). The Whitehead Fund for this purpose was made up of contributions from a large number of Professor Whitehead's friends, and a generous donation from Mrs Whitehead.

In 1978 the Society decided to institute Whitehead Prizes to be funded by the same moneys.

2. The award of the Whitehead Prizes shall be considered annually by the Council of the Society.
3. Normally not more than six Whitehead Prizes shall be awarded in any year.
